

Former Worker Beryllium Testing
(as of December 31, 2003)

The following table provides the number of former DOE workers that were screened for Beryllium exposure. DOE screens former workers in two different programs; The Former Worker Medical Screening Program, in which workers are screened for a variety of potential illnesses, and the Former Worker Beryllium Medical Surveillance Program, which screens specifically for Beryllium exposure. The table reflects the total number of workers from both programs.

These programs are voluntary and ongoing. DOE utilizes a variety of methods to contact former workers and offer these screening programs.
