


FUN IN THE SUN

SCIENCE DAYS!

We Are excited to offer a "Fun in the Sun" Science Day for your local summer programs. Gather your summer students and have fun with several hands on science experiments!

"Fun in the Sun" Science Days will be Tuesdays and Thursdays - starting in June until July 2004.

The science experiments are a one hour hands-on science activities held at your summer camp. This provides an opportunity for children ages 5 through 5th grade to work together to conduct simple, inquiry-based, age-appropriate science activities. The primary goal is to stimulate an excitement and interest in science amongst elementary school children.

Planning your Science Day

1. Decide on a date and contact Cheryl Garcia at Sandia Labs 284.5202 or cagarci@sandia.gov, for availability.
2. Sandia will provide 8 Science experiment stations, including all materials and instructions (Spanish & English).
3. Allow one hour for the Science experiments and one hour for set-up.
4. For this time period, 40 children is the maximum - ages K through 5th grade.
5. Arrange to use a large room and 8 tables.
6. Recruit 2 to 3 staffers to help with activities.
