We want to increase students' opportunities to succeed, and the Challenge helps identify aptitudes that can contribute to future success.

Challenge questions range from easy to challenging. They are designed to test a student's ingenuity and ability to apply learned principles. The test results are used to identify talented students, who—along with their parents and teacher/advisor—will be invited to a recognition banquet. First and second place winners at each grade level receive prizes.

The test must begin on time, so please arrive a few minutes early to check in. Bring sharpened pencils, and, if desired, bottled water and light snacks.
