
## **GRANT OPPORTUNITY 2024**

## Grant amount: \$500-\$3000 Apply: May I-31 | Distribution by July 31



Sandia National Laboratories California will accept applications for its 2024 Success in Climate Change Education for K-12 Youth during the month of May 2024. This competitive grant will be awarded to up to five projects and/ or programs who have not received an education grant award from Sandia during our 2024 grant cycles. Climate change is an urgent and growing threat to national and global security—one that Sandia is committed to addressing through science, technology, and action.

Grant amounts range from \$500 to \$3000 for out-of-classroom time/extended learning programming (i.e., afterschool, inter-sessions or other out-of-classroom time) in which students explore, innovate, and take action in the local community's pathways toward climate resilience. This grant opportunity is open to non-profit organizations in Alameda, South San Joaquin, and East Contra Costa counties who provide educational services to K-12 youth. The purpose of this grant is to support learning, development and action in climate programs and projects in the areas of:

- Humans and ecological systems
- Climate change mitigation
- Energy equity and environmental justice
- Wise use of natural resources
- Plastic and planet
