



By the Numbers

Budget

Sandia received \$5.8 Billion in funding in FY25 from Oct. 1, 2024 through Sept. 30, 2025. Most came through U.S. Department of Energy funds, including \$3.8 Billion under the DOE's National Nuclear Security Administration. Weapons Activities accounted for more than \$3.4 Billion of the NNSA portion, while Defense Nuclear Nonproliferation received \$367 Million.

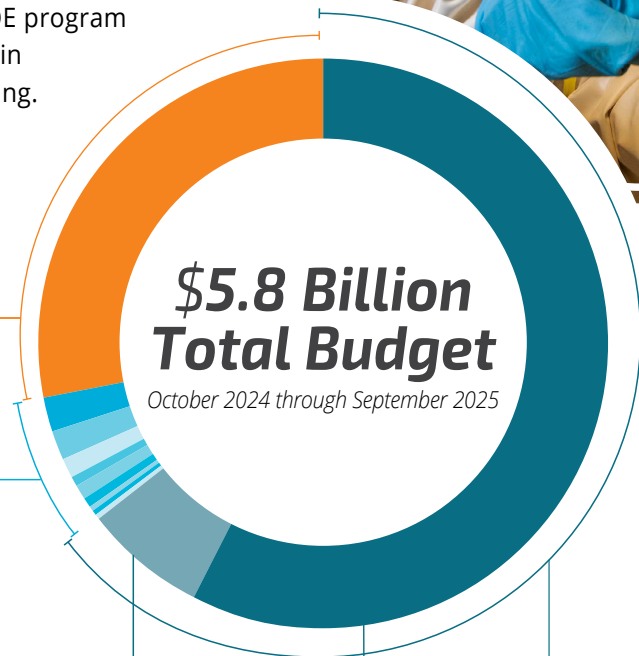
The DOE budget also included funding from various DOE program offices. Sandia also received approximately \$1.6 Billion in Strategic Partnership Projects and other non-DOE funding.

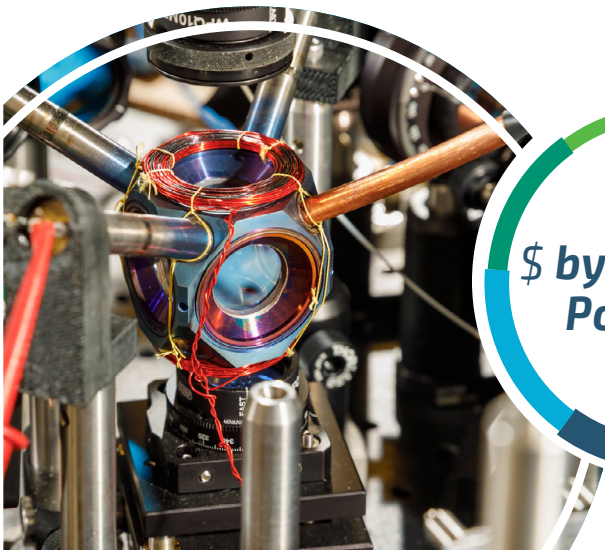

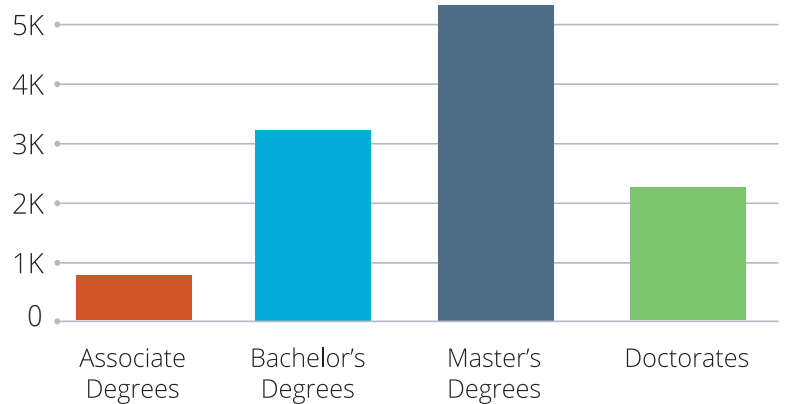
Employees

In FY25, Sandia had a workforce of 16,320, including 13,998 regular employees; 893 limited-term employees; 1,036 students; 376 post-docs; and fewer than 17 faculty/recurrent staff.
