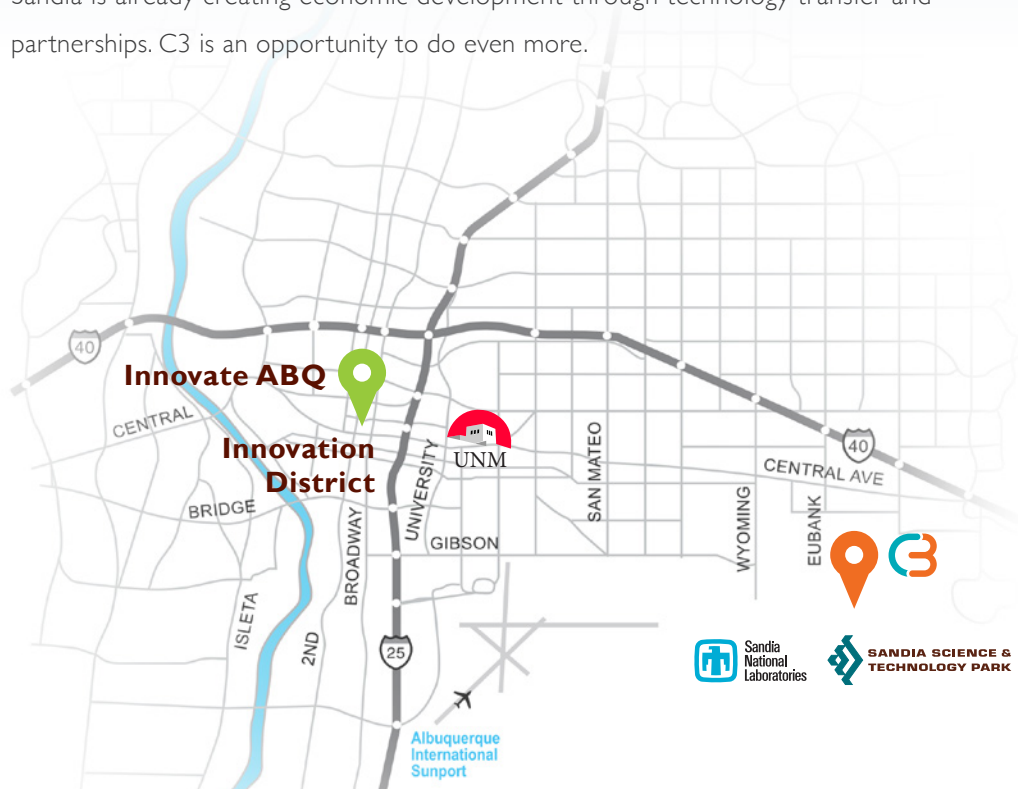

The planned Center for Collaboration and Commercialization (C3) facility in the SS&TP ties into the City of Albuquerque's and the University of New Mexico's Innovation District and Innovate ABQ initiatives. At the eastern end of an innovation corridor that extends along Central Avenue from downtown east to Eubank Boulevard, the SS&TP is already home to companies and organizations that take advantage of the Park's location to give them easy access to the Labs' technologies, facilities, scientists, and engineers.

C3 will be designed to stimulate innovation, cultivate entrepreneurs, and generate jobs. With the city, university, and Sandia working together, C3 will be a fundamental differentiator for Albuquerque, helping to promote economic growth for the region.
